The Storyteller

- Lead with narrative What problem were you solving? Who was the user?
- Curate your journey Show your process, challenges, and decisions.
- Make it human What did you learn? What do you care about?




The Artist

- **Grab attention** Make your strongest work pop in the first 5 seconds.
- Consistency Align visuals across your CV, website, and socials.
- **Design that speaks** Your layout, colour palette, and typography should reflect your creative voice.

Why are you sharing this portfolio?


Is it for a job application, a live interview, teaching

Meet Arjit Singh 28, Canada




