Motivation and Advice:

How to land your first design job?

It's not about knowing everything but about having two or three strong skills that define you and help shape your unique style. Your portfolio should clearly communicate: This is who I am, and this is what I do best.

I found **soft networking** to be super critical. Having to learn to deal with this navigating small talk and speaking to professionals as a student was really scary at first, but practicing that skill was very critical to finding my first job.

Just do whatever you're scared of doing, just go for it. Apply for the job. Ask a person for advice. Look for opportunities in your area. Talk to people, learn new skills, just go for it. And don't be afraid of failure.

Tips and Activities to Build Confidence

SELF-NEUTRALITY



Facts about yourself, such as your credentials. It focuses on facts rather than emotional self-judgement, helping reduce anxiety to overcome doubt and imposter syndrome

BRAG LISTS

A list of past accomplishments; including big, small or unconventional achievements to boost confidence. It's about reminding yourself about unique or challenging accomplishments to build self-assurance.



MENTORSHIP



Having a more experienced mentor provide guidance can be invaluable. It not only helps build confidence but also creates a supportive relationship with someone who believes in you as you begin your design career.



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
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
