It's not about knowing everything but about having two or three strong skills that define you and help shape your **unique style**. Your portfolio should clearly communicate: This is who I am, and this is what I do best.

I found **soft networking** to be super critical. Having to learn to deal with this navigating small talk and speaking to professionals as a student was really scary at first, but practicing that skill was very critical to finding my first job.
