### Paper presentations

Your extended abstract should provide a succinct summary of the final paper being submitted. Briefly state what was done and how, by whom and what conclusions were drawn.

Some important things to remember:

- Extended abstracts must be submitted in English
  - Content should be clear and concise
  - Title should be dynamic and conclusive
  - 800-1000 words excluding images and references
  - References, images, tables or graphics may be included
  - No changes can be made to paper abstracts after submission
  - Paper abstracts can only be submitted under one sub-theme
  - References to all works must be cited
  - Aim to get an objective review of your abstract prior to submission
  - Presentations for forum (if selected) will be due 11 February 2022
  - Final papers if selected: 2000 words minimum (due 11 March 2022)

### Poster presentations

Posters should provide clear information on objectives, approach, main results and conclusions of the research in a visually appealing manner. Posters will be displayed during the event, on WDO.org, as well as on the WDO's event platform to enable attendees to connect with submitters.

Some important things to remember:

- Maximum dimensions for final submissions are 24 in x 36 in
- Poster submissions should be in PDF only (500MB maximum)
- Posters can only be submitted under one sub-theme
- No changes can be made to posters after submission deadline
- Posters should not contain a lot of detail
- Posters should acknowledge support received (i.e. include logos of academic and/or financial sponsors)

### Video presentations

New to the Research and Education Forum this year is the submission of video presentations. Your video should provide a succinct personal reflection on one of the themes. Video submissions should:

- Be one (1) minute at a minimum and must not exceed two (2) minutes
- Videos can only be submitted under one sub-theme
- Provide a personal reflection on the theme
- No changes can be made to videos after submission deadline
- Include your name, institution or associated organization
- Not exceed 500 MB and be submitted in .mov or .mp4 format
